Come and celebrate as the Library celebrates its 10th birthday!

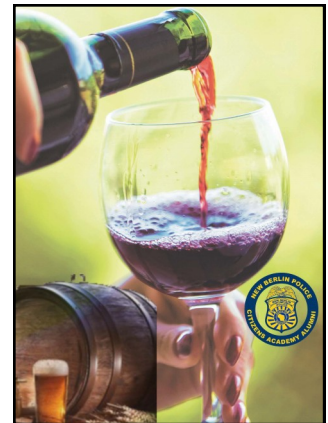


Talking Trash...
