The City of Muskego will be hosting an Electronics & Appliance collection event on Saturday, May 2nd from 10am to 12pm in their City Hall Parking Lot. Bring your electronic devices and appliances. Freon appliances are accepted.

Grass Clippings & Appliances Now Accepted at New Berlin Recycling Center

The City wishes to clarify that the New Berlin Recycling Center *will* be accepting grass clippings. Information outlined in the most recent Summer 2015 City Leaflet is *no longer accurate*. However, the City strongly encourages “grasscycling” which is the natural recycling of grass by leaving clippings on the lawn when mowing. Grass clippings which are 80% water decompose quickly, returning valuable nutrients back to the soil. It saves time and reduces turf grass fertilizer and water requirements.

In addition, appliances such as stoves, refrigerators, washers, dryers, microwaves, dehumidifiers and water heaters are also now accepted. This is in addition to used anti-freeze, car batteries, yard waste, cans, cardboard, dirt, sod, glass, bottles, paper, used motor oil, plastic (#1,2,4,5,&7) and scrap metal (motors must be drained of gas & oil).

Items not accepted by the Recycling Center include: computers, TVs, electronics, household batteries, propane tanks, carpeting, styrofoam, furniture, finished lumber, landscape ties, ashes, rocks, roots, stumps, hazardous materials (paints, cleaners, gas, etc), tires, concrete, cooking oils, construction debris, bricks, windows and mirrors.

The Recycling Center is located at 3711 S Casper Drive. Spring/Summer Hours run through 12/5/2015 and are Tuesdays & Thursdays 10 am – 7 pm and Saturdays 8 am – 4pm. The Center is closed for major holidays.

We ask residents to please keep in mind that recycling is an evolving industry, and therefore things are subject to change. The City of New Berlin will make every effort to accommodate our residents while taking into consideration convenience, cost and environmental impact.

Residents are encouraged to attend the Home Composting Workshop on April 23th and the Clean Water, Healthy Lawn Workshop on May 14th both at 6:30 pm at Poplar Creek Gardens at 16980 W National Avenue in New Berlin.
