Talkin' Trash...

Will yard waste and leaf pickup automatically be included with our service?

Yard waste collection is *not* automatically included. However, residents may contract for yard waste pick-up directly with Advanced Disposal at the city-negotiated price of \$91.75/year/household. This includes a monthly collection of yard waste between April 1st and November 30th.
