City of New Berlin District 2 Equipment Malfunction

New Berlin, Wisconsin— The Community Relations/City Clerk’s Department was informed last night at approximately 8:30PM that one of the tabulating machines located at the New Berlin Community Center – District 2, Wards 4-7 was unable to transmit results to Waukesha County.

After numerous attempts to resolve the issue, the Waukesha County Clerk’s Office determined that the memory stick with the results had malfunctioned. The Waukesha County Clerk’s Office was tasked with programming new memory sticks and delivering them to New Berlin City Hall along with two additional tabulating machines.

Alongside of the Waukesha County Clerk’s Office, the City Clerk’s Office re-fed all District 2 (Wards 4-7) ballots into the machines with the new memory sticks.

After all ballots had been fed through the machines, the City Clerk’s Office was able to successfully transmit the results to the Waukesha County Clerk’s Office.

At this time all results from the City of New Berlin have been reported to Waukesha County.

The integrity of all elections has always been and will continue to be of the utmost importance to the City of New Berlin.
