Both meals include:


- Tomato Basil Soup

## Recipe of the Month

### **Amish Chicken Casserole**

1/2 cup butter  
1/3 cup all-purpose flour  
2 cups chicken broth  
1 cup milk  
1 teaspoon salt  
1/2 teaspoon black pepper  
8 ounces medium egg noodles, cooked  
2 cups rotisserie chicken, shredded  
8 ounces fresh mushrooms, sliced  
1 small onion, chopped  
2 tablespoons fresh parsley, chopped  
1/4 cup parmesan cheese, grated

- 1.) Pre-heat oven to 350 degrees and grease a 9x13 inch baking dish.
- 2.) In a medium sauce-pan, make the sauce by melting the butter over medium heat. Whisk in the flour until no lumps remain.
- 3.) Stir in the broth and milk and bring to a boil. Reduce heat and allow to simmer until thickened. Stir in the salt and pepper. Keep warm on low while preparing the rest of the casserole.
- 4.) In a large bowl, add the noodles, chicken, mushrooms, onion, and parsley. Pour in the sauce and stir to coat. Transfer to the baking dish and sprinkle on the cheese.
- 5.) Bake for 25 minutes, until thoroughly heated. Serve immediately.





# *April Day Trip*



## Say “Cheese” and Beer of Course!!

**Tuesday, April 16, 2019**

In Green County they say “cheese is life” but there’s more for sale than just cheese.

Join your fellow NBSCC travelers for an interesting and delightful day of touring in Monroe, WI. Our motorcoach will depart from the New Berlin Community Center at 8:00 AM on Tuesday, April 16, 2019.

We will travel directly to Monroe for our first morning stop at **Alp & Dell Cheese Shop**. Enjoy plenty of sampling, a viewing tour of their cheese factory and an entertaining performance by “Tony” the town’s famous yodeler. There will be time allowed to shop the more than 150 types of cheese including the 2016 World champion winning cheese, Grand Cru-Surchoix.

(The U.S. had not won a World Champion cheese competition in over 30 years).

Next, we visit the **National Historic Cheese Making Center**. Enjoy a video on the art of cheese making, visit the museum to view equipment cheese makers used back in the 1900’s through 1970’s and see the 100 year old restored cheese factory. Everyone today will receive a treat bag after our tour. (A portion of this tour is not heated, please dress appropriately).

Enjoy lunch today at **Turner Hall of Monroe**. Built in 1808, it is the only Turner Hall of Swiss origin left in the United States. We will be dining in the Grand Hall today and our hot buffet menu includes the following:

Chicken Parmesan, Pork Loin with Apple Maple Bourbon Compote, Baked Rosti Potatoes, Swiss Green Beans with Bacon, Rolls & Butter and Plated Salads with House Dressing. Beverages—Coffee, Iced Tea, and Soda, and Swiss Cream Pie for Dessert.

As a special treat for our group, Mr. Bill Ross, ambassador to Monroe and former mayor (18 years) will meet us at Turner Hall and share a little history of this unique area.

This afternoon, enjoy a visit to **Minhas Craft Brewery**, the oldest brewery in the Midwest and second oldest brewery in the nation. We will gather in their tasting room to view a video on the history and accomplishments earned by this brewery. You will then have the opportunity to sample from over 40 different beer choices available. Everyone will receive a beer and/or soda gift pack as a remembrance of our visit.

We will return to New Berlin around 5:30 PM. The cost of this tour is \$63.00 per person. This includes all morning cheese attractions, lunch, brewery tour, gifts, and deluxe motorcoach transportation.
