City Center is Open During Construction

Talkin' Trash...

Extra bags and loose items on the ground will NOT be picked up – this includes both garbage and recyclables. The materials must be in the carts for tipping into the trucks. The lid of the cart does not need to be closed if material is propping it

open. If there are extra garbage bags, small trash items or recyclables that won't fit, residents will have to hold onto the material until the next pickup day. As a result, if you think you need the larger 96 gallon garbage cart rather than the 64 gallon garbage cart that was originally delivered, now is the time to make your request to Advanced Disposal Services at 262-367-6040. There will be no charge for the larger cart if requested by July 31st. After that date there will be a charge of \$30 for the larger cart.
