South Moorland Road Corridor Neighborhood Plan

The City of New Berlin is currently working on an extensive planning effort and Comprehensive Plan Amendment for the South Moorland Road Corridor area (Sections 34/35). This planning area is generally bounded by Moorland Road to the west, Sunny Slope Road to the east, Grange Avenue to the north and College Avenue to the south. The proposed Future Land Use plan for the South Moorland Road Corridor area includes a mix of Business Park/Industrial land use, Urban Residential land use and a proposed approximately 96 acre park complex. Emphasis on preservation of significant environmental features such as: wetlands, high quality woodlands, tree rows, floodplain and environmental corridors was a high priority in the development of the proposed land use plan. A public hearing will be held at 6:01 PM before the Plan Commission on September 9th, 2015 to present the proposed Comprehensive Plan amendments for the South Moorland Road Corridor area.
