

CITY OF NEW BERLIN BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS BY-LAWS
(as amended September 16, 2013)

TO REPLACE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS ORDINANCE NO. 4, DATED APRIL 29, 1959, revised as listed below:

Ordinance No. 4 created the Board of Public Works on April 29, 1959, consisting of the Mayor, 2 members of the Common Council elected by the Common Council and the City Clerk.

Ordinance No. 139, dated November 22, 1966, amended Section 2.13 of the City Municipal Code by changing the Board composition to the Mayor, Director of Public Works, and three Common Council members elected by the Common Council.

Ordinance No. 160, dated May 9, 1967, amended Section 2.13 of the City Municipal Code by changing the Board composition to the Mayor, Director of Public Works, and three Common Council members elected by the Common Council. The Common Council members shall be elected for a period of two years commencing on May 1st of the odd numbered years. The Board of Public Works shall elect one of its members as Chairman who shall serve for a term of two years commencing on May 1st of the odd numbered years.

Ordinance No. 177, dated November 28, 1967, amended Section 2.13 of the City Municipal Code by changing the Board composition to the Mayor, Director of Public Works, and three Common Council members elected by the Common Council. The Common Council members shall be elected for a period of two years commencing on May 1st of the odd numbered years. The Board of Public Works shall elect one of its members Chairman and one of its members Secretary who shall serve for a term of two years commencing on May 1st of the odd numbered years.

Ordinance No. 396, dated April 23, 1974, amended Section 1.05 of the City Municipal Code to read as follows: 1.05 BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS. (1) BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS. The Board of Public Works shall consist of five members including the Mayor, three Common Council members and Director of Public Works or a member of the Engineering Department, to be elected by the Council in odd-numbered years for a term of two years commencing on May 1st. The Board shall elect one of its members Chairman and one Secretary, who shall serve for terms of two years commencing on May 1st in odd-numbered years.

Ordinance No. 462, dated August 24, 1976, repealed and recreated Section 1.05 (1) of the City Municipal Code to read as follows: The Board of Public Works shall consist of five members including the Mayor, three Common Council members to be appointed by the Council President for a term of one year, and Director of Public Works. The Board shall elect one of its members Chairman and one Secretary, who shall serve for a term of one year.
