WHEREAS, our military veterans have demonstrated the courage to place themselves in harm's way for our freedoms and liberty; and

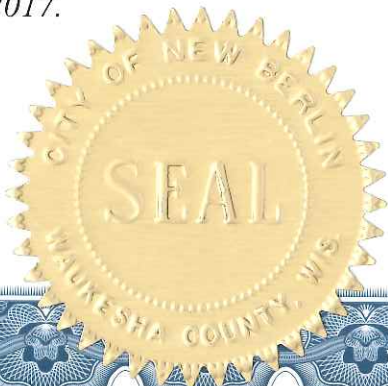
