### DO NOT put the following items in the recycle cart:

- Styrofoam of any kind
- Trash
- Construction materials
- Clothing
- Yard waste

- Electronics

Local clean sweep programs may offer alternative options for disposal of fluorescent light bulbs, household hazardous waste, pharmaceuticals and electronics. ### Yard Waste Subscription Services

Services include one time a month service from April 1st to November 30th at an annual cost of \$98.45

Homeowners shall place yard waste into either compostable paper bags or containers not to exceed thirty-two (32) gallons and which weigh less than fifty (50) pounds.

- Loose branches and twigs shall not be collected unless containerized or bundled with compostable twine, and bundle does not exceed fifty (50) pounds.
- A limit of six (6) bags, containers or bundles may be placed curbside per collection.
- Yard waste includes leaves, grass clippings, yard and garden trimmings and brush, including clean woody vegetative material not greater than six inches in diameter and no longer than six foot in length and weighing no more than fifty (50) pounds but excluding stumps, roots or shrubs with intact root balls.

### CART PLACEMENT

- The arrows on the lid of the cart must point to the street.
- Handles and wheels should face away from the street.
- The garbage cart should be placed within 2 ft. of the street on one side of the driveway.
- The recycle cart should be placed within 2 ft. of the street on the other side of the driveway.
- Please keep 3 ft. of clearance between the carts and other objects, especially mailboxes and vehicles.

### WEEKLY BULK COLLECTION

Items must be manageable by one person, not to exceed 50 lbs. If bulk items exceed the size/weight limits, or are appliances (refrigerators, stoves, washer/dryers), residents must contact Customer Care to schedule pick-up. Charges may be applicable for large items.

- Item not to exceed 50 pounds
- One bulk item per week

If item does not fit the above requirements, charges may apply.

### ACCEPTABLE BULK ITEMS

- Furniture
- Carpeting (no larger than 4 ft. rolled and tied)
- Large metal items

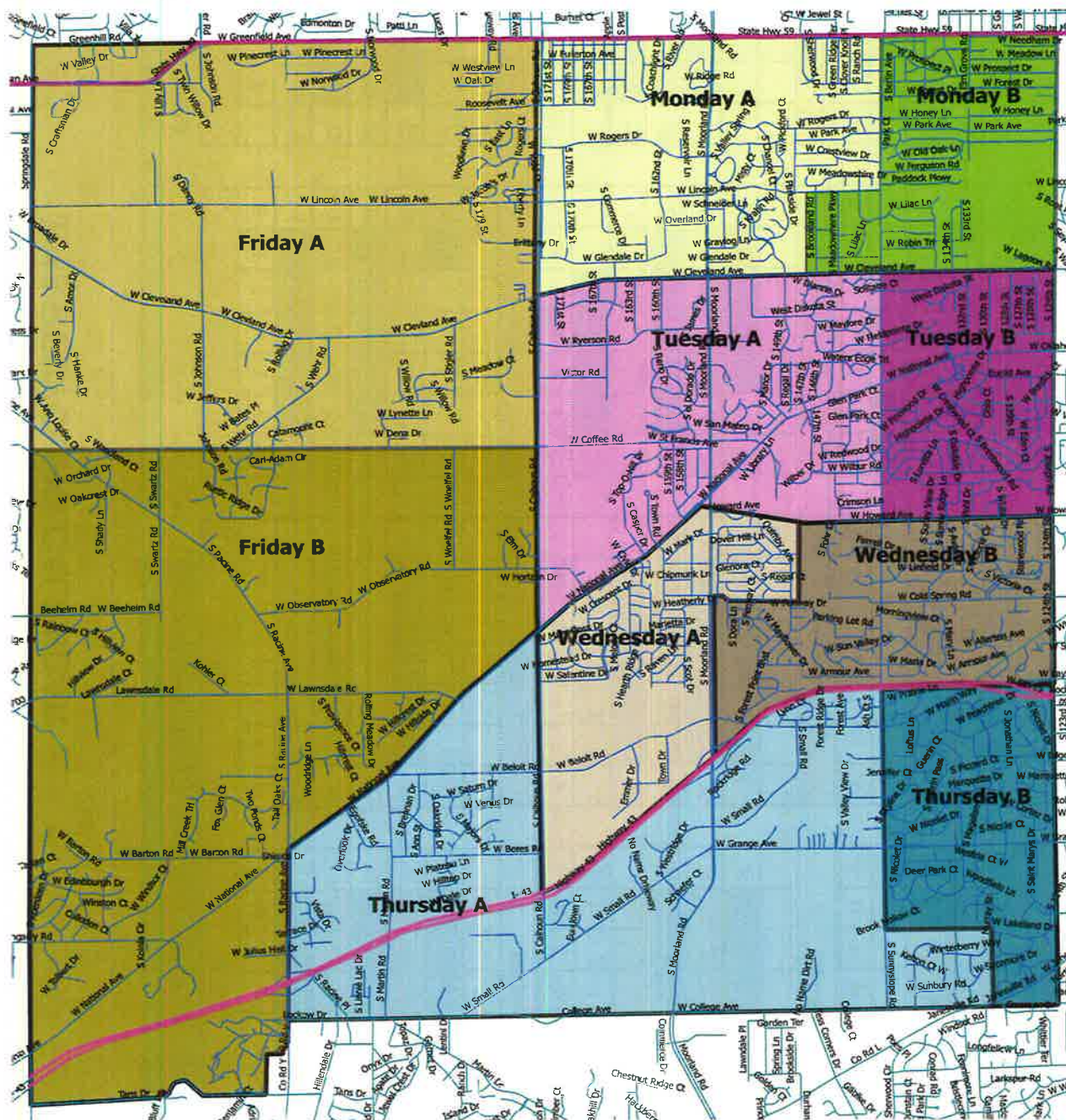
All items for bulk pick up should be placed within 2 ft. of curbside.

### UNACCEPTABLE BULK ITEMS

- Electronics
- Hazardous materials
- Liquid waste (ie: wet paint)

# City of New Berlin Trash & Recycling Service Schedule

For households on boundary streets, please note the following: homes on North/South boundaries will be serviced on the Western Service Day. Homes on East/West Boundaries will be serviced on the Northern Service Day. Examples: homes located on either side of Calhoun Road will be serviced on Fridays; homes located on either side of Cleveland Avenue will be serviced on Mondays.
