The meeting was called to order at 6:30 PM.

Approval of Minutes:

Greg Bybee motioned that the minutes from August 20, 2002, be approved. Ashley Stocks seconded the motion, and it was unanimously approved.

Old Business:

E-mail Regulations:

Publicity

The Battle of the Bands will be advertised in the New Berlin Citizen, and flyers have been posted at both New Berlin high schools, among other locations.

Activities, Music, Police Supervision

In addition to bands, which have already been settled, there will be balls (basketball, volleyball, etc.) available for kids to play with. The bands have met with YAB members and discussed what they'll need, and everything is scheduled for the battle. There will be sufficient police supervision at the event, and one of the judges will be a police officer.

Old Library Usage Proposal Discussion:

Discussion on the location of the new library and usage of old library was delegated to the Facilities committee. They will hold a meeting to discuss the issues. The Algoma trip discussion was postponed due to Jim Gatzke's absence.

Parks & Recreation Department Programs:

A teen yoga class was discussed as a future Park and Rec program, and a survey to teens about desired programs was suggested. The yoga class would cost \$50 for a six-week class taught by a professional instructor. The board agreed that many teens would likely be interested in taking the class despite the cost.

Skate Park Discussion:

To give suggestions about a skate park, it was suggested to talk to Mark Schroeder at Park and Rec meeting. Quarry Park, if it is built, would be a possible location for a skate park.

2003 Budget Requests:

The executive committee met and discussed budget requests, and decided to request funds to

have a professional survey the current library to help decide what it could be used for.

If the Youth Board has a desire to be involved in the planning of next year's Fourth of July, Mary Berg should be contacted. Teen input has been requested.

New Business:

Library Discussion:

There is a college fair at the library on November 20, 2002. Teens are encouraged to use the library to make photocopies, and an Employment Board with job opportunities for teens will be posted soon. The library will be receiving a new magazine called Teen Ink, which is made by teens for teens, and is a nationally-distributed magazine. Also, Melissa Schneider and her husband will be at the Battle of the Bands at around 5:00 PM.
