Relay For Life:

Live Entertainment

The live entertainment section was sent to the Youth Opportunities Committee. Their duties will include coordinating music for the Relay. This will include coordinating a band, meeting with New Berlin West principal David LaBorde for permission to use the sound system. The noise ordinance (and a possible extension) should be taken into consideration. They will also speak with church and/or school choirs about performing at the event.

Sports Games

The Sports/Decathlon section was sent to the Executive Committee. Ashley Stocks will speak with New Berlin West's PE department and/or New Berlin Eisenhower's PE department in regards to Sports equipment for the event. Tom Riese suggested contacting the New Berlin Park and Rec Department for additional equipment. The Executive Committee will also be responsible for coordinating special laps, relays, and decathlon events.

Non-Sports Activities

Non-Sports activities were sent to the Facilities Committee. Their responsibilities will include creating an icebreaker questionnaire, a flashlight candy hunt, coordinating the scavenger hunt, and prizes. Tom Riese suggested that the scavenger hunt should be a random call rather than a list to find; i.e., someone calls out "a red shoe with yellow laces" and the first team to come up with this combination gets the points.

Other Activities

Other activities to include opening and closing ceremonies, special laps, and any other miscellaneous details, was sent to the Programs Committee.

Develop a finalized list of all activities in chronological order

Maja Middleton suggested that we wait to finalize a list until we have more information (bands, ceremonies being planned by other committees, etc.) Chris Teerlinck will provide a list of events from the Racine Relay For Life.

Noise ordinances and/or loudspeaker permit

Mayor Wysocki suggested that we check on a morning ordinance. Megan Mozina and Maja Middleton will speak with New Berlin West Principal David LaBorde about the loudspeaker, as well as the New Berlin Police Department regarding to the noise ordinance.

Miscellaneous Details

Maja Middleton will meet with New Berlin West principal in regards to using the Soccer Fields for tents. Greg Bybee suggested that committees hold meetings to work on their part of the relay. He reminded everyone to follow proper procedure at these meetings (posting the agenda 24 hours in advance, secretary needs to take minutes).

Tom Riese reported that in the near future the City of Muskego will be developing their own Youth Board. He suggested that we might consider some type of interaction with them in August or September to help them get started.
