Twenty-three (23) members from the NBJWC participated in a "Stop the Bleed" training on February 13th to gain first-hand knowledge of this national 90-minute public education program. Uncontrolled bleeding is the number one cause of preventable death from trauma and for this reason the City of New Berlin is committed to "Stop the Bleed" training.

The New Berlin Junior Woman's Club, now in its 44th year, are a group of women committed to serving and strengthening the New Berlin Community through fundraising, volunteerism and friendship. The NBJWC helps fund initiatives with the New Berlin Police and Fire Departments annually and was the driving force behind the Malone Park All-Inclusive Playground.
