Permission is hereby granted to the above named person to erect temporary barricade(s) in compliance with the provisions of the City of New Berlin Municipal Code 230-6(B), which states, "Any property owner may apply to the Police Department for a permit to use a portion of the public street adjacent to his property for recreational purposes to be conducted by the applicant. If the Chief of Police determines that such permit shall be granted, barricades shall be obtained by the applicant from the Highway Department and shall be installed by the applicant upon those portions of the street to be used for recreational purposes, and such barricades shall be installed in such a manner as to prevent vehicular traffic upon such sections of the public street upon which such recreational activities are to be conducted, except that such barricades shall be readily removable in case of required use of the portions of the street barricaded by emergency vehicles. The applicant shall install the barricades immediately prior to the commencement of the recreational activities for which such permit is granted and shall remove the same at the termination of such permit and return the same to the Highway Department. The applicant shall be responsible for any damage to barricades and shall reimburse the City therefor as determined by the City Highway Department. No fee shall be charged for such permit."
