Contact their personal healthcare provider *directly* to arrange for vaccination **or** contact your local pharmacy directly.

Other options.....

- Complete the Waiting List for COVID-19 Vaccine to be placed on the Waukesha County COVID-19 Vaccine Waitlist. Residents do **not** need to register every week as was required previously.
- Visit the WI Map of Vaccine Providers. This interactive map is designed to help residents connect with vaccine providers in the area thereby easing the process of knowing where vaccines are available and which parts of the population each site is serving.

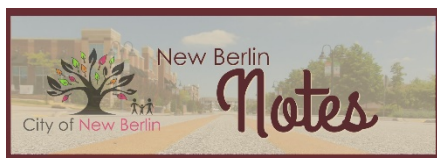
