

COVID-19 Vaccination Update

3/17/21

Vaccine eligibility moves to next phase on Monday 3/22/21

People age 16 and up with certain preexisting conditions in Wisconsin will be eligible for the coronavirus vaccine starting Monday, 3/22/21.

Qualifying conditions include:

Asthma	High blood Pressure
Cancer	Immunocompromised state
Cerebrovascular disease	Liver disease
Chronic kidney disease	Neurologic conditions
COPD	Overweight with a BMI of ≥ 25
Cystic fibrosis	Pregnancy
Diabetes	Pulmonary fibrosis
Down Syndrome	Sickle cell disease
Heart conditions	Thalassemia

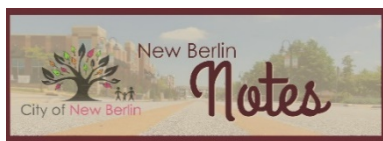
Contact their personal healthcare provider *directly* to arrange for vaccination **or** contact your local pharmacy directly.
