



Dear Dancers and Parents,

Welcome to the exciting world of dance! We are pleased you have chosen to participate in the New Berlin Recreation's Dance program. We value this opportunity to provide you with safe, affordable, quality dance instruction. We strive to create a fun-filled environment where each student can thrive at their pace!

Here is what you can expect. Our classes are designed to give students an introduction to dance structure and movement vocabulary, and to foster an appreciation of dance. During each class session, students will develop skills appropriate for their age and level. Each level of instruction builds on skills learned in previous levels.

To help us keep classes running smoothly and safely, please take note of the following procedures:

Visitation: We ask that parents/guardians and siblings please remain in the hallway during class time. For parent/child classes, adults will be allowed in the classroom. We encourage active participation from all students and want to ensure there are no distractions.

Attendance: Please be on time and have your dancer use the bathroom before they start class. Children must be checked into class by an adult. Please do not drop off your participant outside of the recreation center and have them walk in alone.

Attire: Students should wear something they can stretch and move in easily, and which does not impede movement. We suggest the following:

Dance Out Your Sillies & Creative Movement: Any dance outfit (leotards, body suits, or t-shirts and gym shorts). Tennis shoes or socks, ballet shoes optional.

Ballet & Tap: Any dance outfit (leotards or body suits for girls and t-shirts and gym shorts for boys). Ballet slippers and tap shoes are required. Please no bare feet. We will have a few used pairs of ballet & tap shoes available to try on and purchase on the first day of class (cash only).

Hip Hop: Pants or shorts, with a t-shirt or leotard, sweat clothes, and athletic shoes with smooth soles.

Cheer/Poms: Pants or shorts, with a t-shirt or leotard, sweat clothes, and athletic shoes with smooth soles and pom poms (for poms).

Shoes: Please only wear your dance shoes inside. Come to dance with street shoes and change into your shoes after you enter the building.

PLAYGROUND USE POLICIES:
