

Hot Tubs

Application Requirements

1. New Berlin application form completed
2. Manufacturers brochure showing listing of unit i.e. (UL, ETL, etc).
3. Tub enclosures require framing plan
4. Requires separate electric permit by a **licensed contractor**

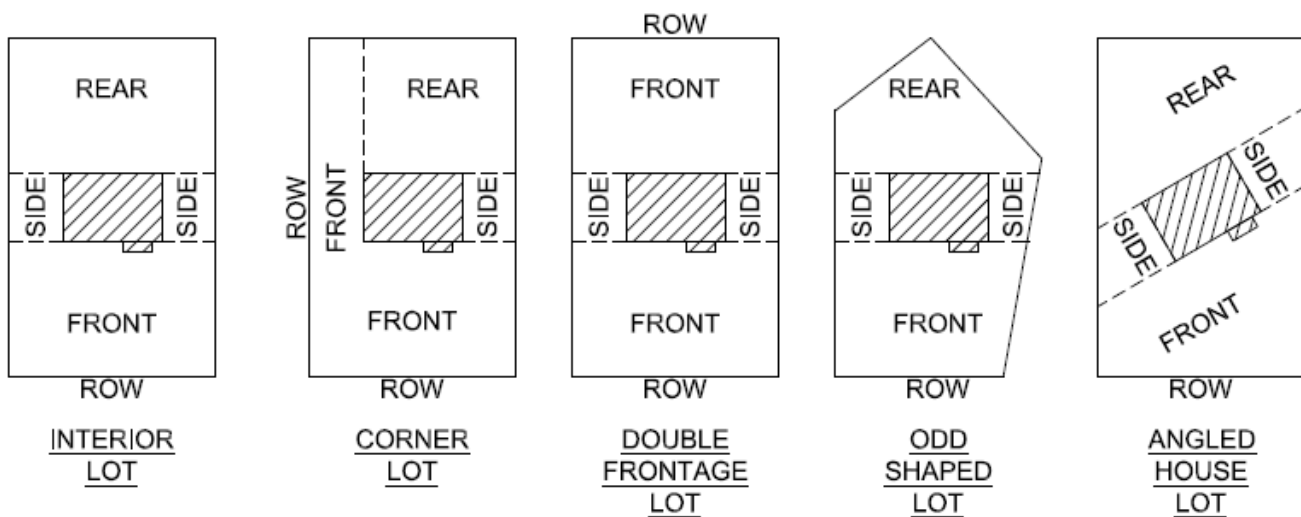
Guidelines

Separation from overhead and underground electrical wiring shall be in accordance with the State of Wisconsin Electrical Code and/or local code (overhead wiring must be minimum of 10' horizontally from the inside wall of the pool and underground wiring must be minimum of 5' horizontally from the inside wall of the pool/hot tub). Required electrical wiring supplying all pools/hot tubs shall be installed in accordance with Article 680 of the National Electrical Code (N.E.C.). Please note, an electric permit is required before any electrical work is performed.

Location

1. Hot tub may be located in the side or rear yard.
 - a. Hot tubs located in the side yard shall meet the setbacks of the Zoning District.
 - b. Hot tubs located in the rear yard shall be located a minimum of 5' from all property lines.
2. May be permitted as close as necessary to a principal or accessory building.
3. Maximum height of hot tub enclosure is 15'.
